

AN INVITATION TO NORTH OLMSTED RESIDENTS

As you may or may not know, the North Olmsted School Board is currently having discussions to build a 185 foot wind turbine on the school grounds, possibly behind the North Olmsted Middle School off Butternut Ridge Road. The 250-kilowatt turbine will cost about \$850,000.

Legislation was read at the last City Council meeting to introduce an ordinance providing for the amendment of the Zoning Code for the City of North Olmsted in order to permit and establish regulations for the use of Wind Energy Systems in the City of North Olmsted.

This legislation will be on the Agenda of the Planning and Design Commission at their next meeting. If you want your voices heard, please plan on attending this meeting of the Commission. See details below on the time and location of the meeting.
